Thank you for your interest in the Henderson County Master Gardener Program. ***Please read this letter carefully, complete and sign the enclosed application and return it to the address listed on the application by August 23<sup>rd</sup>.*** You will also need to register at Trinity Valley Community College in Athens and pay for the class which is \$135. The text for the class will be the Texas Master Gardener Handbook.

The following will help you better understand the functions and requirements of the Texas Master Gardener Program. ***This program is operated under the authority and guidance of the Texas Master Gardener Association and the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. The purpose of the Master Gardener Program is to enhance the ability of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service to provide public education programs in the areas of horticulture and gardening utilizing the volunteer efforts of certified volunteer Master Gardeners and Master Gardener interns.***

The 2017 class of Henderson County Master Gardeners will be limited. First preference will be given to qualified residents of Henderson County. ***Individuals participating in the Master Gardener program are required to attend a 13 week (52 hours) training course in plant and horticultural science and pass a test at the end of the course. You are expected to attend all sessions.***

***During your "intern" year, you must also devote a minimum of fifty (50) hours of Master Gardener volunteer service on Master Gardener projects in Henderson County.*** You will be given a number of HCMG projects to choose from. Some of these hours may be worked on the project of your choice, while others may be assigned according to the needs of the community and the Extension Horticulture program. A specific number of those hours will be required at the East Texas Arboretum, the County Extension office, the HCMG fundraisers and other projects of HCMG.

Once you have completed the requirements and been certified, you are expected to maintain your certification and membership through annual volunteer requirements.

We are seeking persons who have some basic experience, skills and/or knowledge in gardening, ornamental horticulture, vegetable gardening and/or related areas. We are also seeking volunteers who would be able to communicate with the public by telephone, personal contact, group programs, or through written correspondence.
